

Anker Reference Value Update¹ Urban Cambodia 2022

Living Wage KHR 947,493 (USD 231)

This report updates the Anker Living Wage Reference Value for Urban Cambodia to 2022. The updated values for June 2022 are: (i) Anker Gross Living Wage of: KHR 947,493 (USD 231), comprised of a Net Living Wage of KHR 928,543 (USD 227), plus a social security contribution of KHR 18,950 (USD 4). This was KHR 860,992 (USD 210) for 2021 in the original report,² equivalent to the net living wage (i.e. takehome pay), given there were no payroll deductions whatsoever at that point. Inflation in this period was 7.85%³ and it increased the net living wage. Without accounting for inflation, the living wage estimated in 2021 would not be sufficient for families to have a basic but decent standard of living in 2022, because the purchasing power of the living wage would have decreased. Social security contributions and income tax were calculated using the most up-to-date tax laws (e.g. the introduction of social security contributions in 2022, there were inexistent in 2021).⁴
