

Anker Reference Value Update¹ Non-metropolitan Urban Chile 2022

Living Wage CLP 727,536 (USD 818)

This report updates the Anker Living Wage Reference Value for non-metropolitan urban Chile to 2022. The updated values for 2022 are: (i) Anker Gross Living Wage of: CLP 727,536 (USD 818), comprised of a Net living Wage of CLP 599,490 (USD 674), plus a social security and pension contributions of CLP 128,046 (USD 144). The Anker Living Wage Reference Value for 2020 was CLP 623,057 (USD 751) in the original report², comprised of a net living wage (i.e. take-home pay) of CLP 513,399 (USD 619) per month plus CLP 109,658 (USD 132) which would need to be paid by law in social security and pension contributions on the living wage. Inflation in 2022 for the period in which the living wage estimate was calculated was 16.77%³ and it increased the net living wage. Without accounting for inflation, the living wage estimated in 2020 would not be sufficient for families to have a basic but decent standard of living in 2022, because the purchasing power of the living wage would have decreased. Social security and pension contributions and income tax were calculated using the most up-to-date laws.⁴
