



## **Anker Living Income Reference Value Update** Rural Madagascar<sup>1</sup> 2022

Living Income MGA 580,155 (USD 143)

This report updates the Anker Living Income Reference Value for rural Madagascar to 2022, estimated to be MGA 580,155 (USD 143) for 2022. In the original report, the Reference Value was MGA 512,693 (USD 140) for 2020.2 This update takes into account the amount of inflation to mid-2022 for the country since mid-2020. Accumulated inflation in this period was 13.16%.3 Without accounting for inflation, the living income estimated in 2020 would not be sufficient for families to have a basic but decent standard of living in 2022, because the purchasing power of the living income would have decreased.
